

CHAPTER 146.

AN ACT to add additional sections to the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, Chapter three hundred and seventy-seven, to be embraced in the twenty-second Article of the Supplemental Code of Public Local Laws for Wicomico County, sub-title, 'Salisbury,' to follow section ten of said Article.

SECTION 11. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the said Town Commissioners of the town of Salisbury, or a majority of them, shall have full power and authority to straighten and widen old streets, and to open, lay out and grade new ones, whenever in their judgment the same may be necessary, or that the public convenience and improvement may require it, and they or a majority of them shall have full power to provide for the payment of damages and expenses incurred by opening, widening or straightening the streets as aforesaid, by levying and assessing the same generally upon the whole of the assessable property of said town, or upon the property of persons benefitted thereby.

Power of commissioners.

Sec. 12. *And be it enacted,* That the Commissioners who shall hereafter be elected, as provided for in the third section of this Article, shall qualify before the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Wicomico County, and not as provided for in the fourth section of the said Article.

Elected.

Sec. 13. *And be it enacted,* That the Bailiffs appointed by the said Commissioners shall qualify before the Clerk of the Circuit Court of said county, whose bond shall be approved by the Commissioners of Wicomico County, and not before a Justice of the Peace and the County Commissioners, as provided for in section seven of this Article.

Bailiffs.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
