

CHAPTER 153.

An Act entitled an Act to repeal an Act passed January Session eighteen hundred and sixty-six, entitled "An Act to Incorporate a Company to Build a Turnpike Road from Union Bridge, Carroll County, to Unionville, Frederick County," and enact a substitute therefor.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That an Act passed February seventh, eighteen hundred and sixty-six, Chapter fifty-one, entitled "An Act to Incorporate a Company to Build a Turnpike Road from Union Bridge, Carroll County, to Unionville, Frederick County, be and the same is hereby repealed and the following enacted in lieu thereof: Repealed.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That a Company be incorporated to make a turnpike road from Union Bridge, Carroll County, to Unionville, Frederick County, with the privilege of making a lateral or branch road in the direction of Johnsville and Liberty, Frederick County. Lateral road.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the capital stock of said Company shall not exceed thirty thousand dollars in shares of twenty dollars each. Capital stock.

Sec. 4. *And be it enacted,* That subscription books may be opened under the direction of Nathan Euglar, Jesse Myers, H. D. Hartsook, Reuben Taylor, David Stitely, Jesse Anders, John Deihl, George P. Buckley, Thomas Jones, Lott Hartsook, John Clemson, Peter H. Shiner, and David Rinehart, or any three of them, who are hereby appointed Commissioners to receive subscriptions to the capital stock of said Company, and said Commissioners or a majority of them shall fix the time and place of receiving such subscriptions, and the sums so subscribed to the stock of said Company shall be payable to the President and Directors hereinafter provided for in such sums and at such times as they may direct and require. Subscription.

Sec. 5. *And be it enacted,* That when two hundred and fifty shares of said stock shall have been Organize.
