train, and shall receive, transport and discharge such passengers at, from, and to all such places on the due payment of the freight or fare duly authorized therefor, and shall be liable to the party aggrieved in action for damages for any neglect or refusal in the premises.

Tolls.

Sec. 16. And be it enacted, That said Company shall be entitled to charge as tolls a sum not exceeding four cents per ton per mile on all goods, merchandise or property of any description whatsoever transported on said railroad, and also a sum not exceeding four cents per mile for each passenger whom they may transport on said road authorized to be built by this Act.

Make exhibit.

Sec. 17. And be it enacted, That at the regular annual meetings of the stockholders of said Company, it shall be the duty of the President and Directors in office for the preceding year to exhibit a clear and distinct statement of the affairs of the Company, and that any called meetings of the stockholders, or a majority of them present may require similar statements from the President and Directors whose duty it shall be to furnish them thus required, and at any general meeting of the stockholders a majority in value of all the stockholders in said Company may remove from office any President or any Director of said Company, and may appoint others in their stead.

Dividends.

Sec. 18. And be it enacted, That the President and Directors shall annually or semi-annually declare and make such dividends as they may deem proper, of the net profits of the said Company after deducting the necessary current expenses and probable contingent expenses, and that they shall divide the same among the stockholders of said Company in proportion to their respective shares.

Injure or destroy.

Sec. 19. And be it enacted, That if any person or persons shall wilfully by any means whatsoever, impair, injure or destroy any part of said railroad constructed by said Company under this Act, or any of the necessary works, buildings, vehicles or machinery of said Company, such person or persons so offending shall each of them for every such offence forfeit and pay to said Company the actual damages sustained, which may be recovered
