CHAPTER 164.

AN ACT for the relief of Columbus Scarborough of Harford County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Levy annually of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Harford County be and they are hereby authorized to levy on the assessable property of said county the sum of fifty dollars annually for the use of Columbus Scarborough, a helpless cripple living in said county so long as the same may be necessary for his support.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall In force. be in force and take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 165.

AN ACT to incorporate the Patapsco Guano Company of Baltimore.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Incorporation of Maryland, That Francis Neale, Benj. G. Harris, George W. Grafflin and G. A. Leibig, their associates, successors and assigns, be and they are hereby created a body corporate by the name and style of "The Patapsco Guano Company of Baltimore," and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and shall be capable in law to hold and dispose of property, real, personal and mixed, fee simple or leasehold, to sue and be sued, to plead and be impleaded, to answer and defend, and be answered and defended in any Court of law or equity and in any other place whatsoever, to receive and make deeds and contracts, to make, have and use a common seal, and the same to change, alter and renew at pleasure, to ordain and estab-
