CHAPTER 188.

AN ACT to give the assent of the Legislature of this State to a bequest in the will of Susan A. Goodwin, late of Charles County, deceased, to the Vestry of Trinity Parish, in said County.

Legislative assent.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the assent of the Legislature of the State of Maryland be, and the same is hereby given, to a bequest of three thousand dollars, in and by the last will and testament of Susan A. Goodwin, late of Charles County, deceased, to the Vestry of Trinity Parish, in said County.

Sec. 2. An be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 189.

AN ACT to authorize the location of a Public Road in Frederick and Carroll Counties.

Incorporation

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That James H. Steele and Charles A. Lawrence of Frederick County, and Thomas B. Buckingham of Carroll County, be appointed commissioners, with power to examine the location for a public road leading from the Frederick Road, in Frederick County: beginning at a point west of Cochrain's School House Branch, and running thence to the Wooeman Road, north of Talbott's Branch; thence to the Buffalo Road; thence to the Roop Road in Carroll County, and thence to the Gillis Road, by the most convenient and practicable route, and to determine, whether in their opinion, the public interests require a public road to be opened on said location, and if they shall be of that opinion, they shall proceed to locate the same in such manner as may best promote the pub-
