

CHAPTER 205.

AN ACT to repeal Section three of Article thirty-three of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to Indigent Blind, and re-enact the same with amendments.

Repealed and re-enacted. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section three of Article thirty-three of the Code of Public General Laws, relating to "Indigent Blind," be and is hereby repealed, and the following re-enacted in lieu thereof.

Annual appropriation. Sec. 3. A sum not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars shall be annually appropriated to be applied, under the direction of the Governor, in placing for instruction in the Maryland Institution for the instruction of the Blind, such indigent blind persons of the age of nine years and upwards, inhabitants of this State and the county or city from which they are recommended, as may be duly recommended to the Governor by the County Commissioners of each county, and by the Judges of the Orphan's Court of Baltimore City.

In force. Sec. 2. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 206.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's County to levy a sum of money or issue bonds for repairing and altering the Courthouse in said county.

Lay a tax. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners for Queen Anne's County, be, and they are hereby
