erick County, for the use of Elizabeth C. Dorsey, of said county, widow of Vachel W. Dorsey, who was a soldier of the war of 1812,) the sum of eighty dollars, during the natural life of the said Elizabeth C. Dorsey.

In force.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 225.

AN ACT to repeal the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, (1864,) Chapter four hundred and five, relating to the establishment of a uniform system of contracting for Public Printing.

Public printing.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-four, (1864,) Chapter four hundred and five, entitled "An Act to establish a uniform system of contracting for printing all such matter pertaining to and for the use of the Legislature of the State of Maryland, and for Constitutional State Convention," which authorises and requires the Comptroller of the Treasury to contract for the Public Printing, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

In force.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall go into operation and take effect from the day of its passage.
