so much of said provisions as may be applicable thereto.

· Sec. 24. And be it enacted, That should the road Limit. or roads not be commenced within five years from the passage of this Act, and not be finished within ten years thereafter, then this Act shall be null and void.

Sec. 25. And be it enacted, That this Act take Inforce. effect from the date of its passage.
