Sec. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That the Treasurer of the State, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the Worcester Railroad Company twenty-five thousand dollars, and to the Worcester and Somerset Railroad Company the sum of ten thousand dollars upon the same terms and provisos in respect to each of said Companies as are contained in the same original Act, except the proviso mentioned in the first Section of this Act; provided that no part of said sum of ten thousand dollars hereby appropriated to the Worcester and Somerset Railroad shall be used by said road contrary to the original appropriation for internal improvements in Worcester County.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 297.

AN ACT to repeal an Act to repeal the Act of Eighteen hundred and sixty-five, Chapter One hundred and seventy-four, entitled An Act relating to the Registration of the Voters of the State, and to enact other provisions relating to the Registration of Voters in lieu thereof, Chapter three hundred and thirty-six, passed March the thirteenth, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, and to enact other provisions relating to the Registration of Voters in lieu thereof.
