So the amendment was rejected.

The bill as amended was then read a second time.

Mr Harding moved to reconsider the vote by which the fourth section was ordered to a third reading.

Decided in the negative.

The bill was then ordered to be engrossed for a third read, ing.

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 5 of Article 60 of Public General Laws, entitled "Marriages," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
