section 872 of Article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to the city of Baltimore, and re-enact the same with amendments, entitled Taxes and Loans.

On motion of Mr. Stewart, of Dorchester,

The vote by which the bill entitled an Act to increase the number of free scholarships in the Baltimore Female College, and to change the manner of appointing the beneficiaries and Board of Trustees was, on Tuesday last, rejected,

Was reconsidered, and,

On motion of Mr. Stewart, of Dorchester,

Referred to the Committee on Corporations.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following message:

By the Senate, February 6, 1868

Gentlemen of the House of Delegates:

We have received your message requesting this body to recede from certain amendments made to House bill entitled "An Act to incorporate the Continental Fire and Marine Insurance Company of Baltimore," and to which amendments your body refused its concurrence. We would respectfully inform you that the Senate adheres to the amendments referred to, and desires that the House may reconsider its vote of non-currence therein.

Amendments proposed:

Amend 7th section by striking out all after the word "Company," in the 9th line to the end of the section.

Amend 16th section, sixth line, by inserting before the word Company the words "Capital stock of said."

Amend section 16, line 13, by inserting before the word City the word "the."
