

CHAPTER 377.

AN ACT to amend and re-enact Section two hundred and thirteen of Article four of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Election."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section two hundred and thirteen of Article four, Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Elections," be and the same is hereby amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

213. Each of the said judges, as soon as may be after his appointment, and before proceeding to act as such judge of election, shall take the oath or affirmation prescribed by the thirty-fifth Article of the Public General Laws, as amended by the Act of the General Assembly, passed at the January Session thereof, in the year eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, Chapter three hundred and seventy-four, repealing and adopting a substitute for Section nine of said Article, and every clerk of said election, as soon as may be after his appointment, and before he enters any vote on the poll book, shall take the oath or affirmation prescribed in the tenth Section of said Article thirty-five of the Public General Laws; and the said judges and clerks respectively, shall likewise make oath or affirmation well and faithfully to discharge the duties, by this Article, imposed on them respectively, or which may be assigned to them respectively, during their official term by law.
