CHAPTER 410.

AN ACT to repeal the Act of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, Chapter three hundred and sixty-six, entitled "An Act making appropriations for the support of the Government for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-nine," and to substitute the following in lieu thereof:

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Act passed March the twenty-second, eighteen hundred and sixty-seven, Chapter three hundred and sixty-six, entitled "An Act making appropriations for the support of the Government for the year ending the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-nine," be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following sections substituted in lieu thereof: Repealed.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That for the expenditures in the support of the Government for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated, that is to say: Appropriation.

FOR STATE'S OFFICERS.

For the salary of the Governor of Maryland, four thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Secretary of State, two thousand dollars; Salary of Governor, &c.
