On motion of Mr. Kean,

Leave was granted to the Allegany delegation to introduce a bill to repeal section 159 of Article 1, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Allegany county, relating to Sheriffs, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

On motion of Mr. Iglehart,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to report a bill to repeal the 9th section of the Act passed January session, 1867, entitled an Act to incorporate the Annapolis Fruit and Oyster Packing Company, and to re-enact the same so as to read as follows.

Also,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to report a bill to incorporate the Grand United Independent Order of Isaac and Rebecca No. 1, of the city of Annapolis.

On motion of Mr. Mitchell,

Leave was granted to Messrs. Mitchell, Chapman and Loker, to report a bill to repeal sections 93 to 109 inclusive, of Article 9, of Public Local Laws for Charles county, relating to roads, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
