same were herein again repeated, beginning the same at the mines of said Company and running to a convenient point or points on the line of any other railroad or railroads now constructed, or that may hereafter be constructed in Allegany County, and for the using and preserving the said railroad, its necessary vehicles and appurtenances, and every part thereof.

In force.

Sec. 7. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be in force from the date of its passage.

Reservation.

Sec. 8. And be it enacted, That the General Assembly reserves the right to alter or amend or repeal this Act at pleasure.

CHAPTER 429.

AN ACT to incorporate the Peoples' Towing and Transportation Company of Baltimore.

Incorporation

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Wm. McCann, Wm. Davison, Jno. N. Ely, C. E. Coats and T. A. Cunningham, and such other persons as may be associated with them in the manner hereinafter provided, shall be and they are hereby incorporated and made a body politic by the name and style of the "Peoples' Towing and Transportation Company of Baltimore," and by that name shall have succession, and be able to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded in any court of law and equity, and may have and use a common seal, and the same alter and renew at pleasure, and the said Company shall have all the privileges and rights necessary for purchasing, chartering, building, constructing and repairing boats propelled by steam or otherwise for navigating the Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, for the purpose of the conveyance of passengers and towing
