Sec. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the donation of two hundred dollars, now paid to the Trustees of Salisbury Academy, for Somerset County, shall hereafter be paid to the Trustees of Fairmount Academy, in said Somerset County. Donation.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, shall pay annually, on the first Monday in April, to the Board of School Commissioners of Wicomico County, the sum of four hundred dollars, in addition to the sum named in the first Section of this Act, to be applied to the Public School Fund of said county. ### CHAPTER 435.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section ninety-eight of Article sixteen of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Chancery," and relating to service of notice on non-resident defendants.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section ninety-eight of Article sixteen of the Code of Public General Laws, be and the same is hereby repealed, and that there be enacted in lieu thereof the following: Repealed.
