Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Senators and Representatives from this State in the Congress of the United States, are hereby requested to urge upon that body the passage of such laws as honor, justice and the true policy of the country demand, in fully securing to all naturalized citizens the same rights of person and property, both at home and abroad, which are now possessed by the native born.
