WHEREAS, in the civilized world, the custom prevails, that a nation laboring under political grievances; a people conscious of oppressive and unconstitutional measures, rashly pursued towards them by the authorities of the land, or the States of a confederacy feeling that their rights are invaded, their privileges assailed, or their independence as sovereignties denied, shall proclaim to the world and the authorities, that usurp their inalienable rights, their sense of indignation, and their consciousness of violated prerogatives; and
