Add as section 5, And be it enacted, That it is hereby made imperative that the above corporation shall annually appoint a committee of not less than five citizens of the city of Baltimore, who shall make a report of the affairs of said Institution, to be published in at least two daily papers in Baltimore.

Which was adopted.
