On motion of Mr. Offutt,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the Savings Institution of Sandy Spring, Maryland.

On motion of Mr. Maynard,

Leave was granted to the Frederick county delegation to report a bill entitled a supplement to the Act entitled an Act to incorporate a company to build a turnpike road from Libertytown, Frederick county, through Johnsville to Pipe Creek, passed January session, 1864, chapter 338.

On motion of Mr. Keech,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the Marlboro' and Patuxent River Rail Road Company to locate, lay out, construct and operate a railroad from a point on the Baltimore and Potomac Rail Road, not over a mile from Upper Marlboro', to a point on the Patuxent River not higher up than Hill's Landing, and not lower down than Mount Calvert.
