Add at end of section 8, the words "provided that the State shall be subjected to no expense for any such office."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Davis, of Cecil, submitted the following amendment:

Sec. 10, strike out all after the word "inability," in line 5.

Which was rejected.

Mr. Latrobe submitted the following amendment :

Section 14, line 3, strike out the word "or."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Latrobe submitted the following amendment :

Section 14, after the word "battalion," line 3, insert the words "or squadron to which said company belongs."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Latrobe submitted the following amendment :

Section 14, line 5, strike out the words "regiment, battery, or battalion, and insert the word "company."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Latrobe submitted the following amendment :

Section 14, line 7, strike out the word "militia," and insert the word "military."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Latrobe submitted the following amendment :

Section 14, line 8, after the word "herein," insert the word "before."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Harden submitted the following amendment :

Section 14, line 12, strike out the words "for the use of said company."

Which was rejected.
