

The bill entitled an Act appointing a Committee with authority to purchase a lot or lots of ground in the city of Annapolis, and causing to be erected thereon a mansion for the Governor of this State, and making an appropriation therefor.

Being upon a second reading,

Mr. Wenner submitted the following amendment :

Section 1. line 2, insert the name of Dr. Wm. S. McPherson, Superintendent of Labor and Agriculture, after the words "Governor of this State."

Which was rejected.

Mr. Mitchell submitted the following amendment :

Add at the end of section 1, line 10, and provided further that the said committee shall report to the General Assembly of Maryland the site selected by them, which report shall be confirmed and adopted by the General Assembly before the committee shall close such purchase.

Which was adopted.

Mr. Iglehart moved a reconsideration of the vote by which the said amendment was adopted.

Decided in the negative.

The bill as amended was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

And having been engrossed,

Mr. Iglehart moved that the bill be read a third time this day, in accordance with section 27, Article 3d of the Constitution.
