

The bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 134 and 135 of Article 8, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub-title "North East,"

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal section 11, of Article 7, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Carroll county," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments,

Being upon a second reading,

Mr. Harden submitted the following amendment:

Add at end of section 11, Provided, that the said Commissioners shall not allow the said Clerk any extra compensation for any services he may render said Commissioners.

Which was rejected.

The bill was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
