The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal the 89th section of Article 16 of the Code of Public General Laws entitled Chancery, and relating to process against non-resident infant defendants, as amended by the Act of 1864, chapter 89, and to insert in said Article in lieu of the section so repealed the following section relating to process against non-resident infant defendants, with proposed amendments.

Amendments proposed :

Amend, after the words "United States," in second line of section 89, by inserting the words "or any territory thereof."

After the word "party," in the 4th line of said section, by inserting the words "or parties."

After the word "him," by striking out the word "or," and after the word "her," in the 15th line of said section, by inserting the words "or them, and that he, she or they have made diligent inquiry to ascertain the same, (the said oath or affirmation, where there is more than one party complainant to be made by any one, any number, or all of such parties in the discretion of the court,) or when a commission may have been issued, as herein provided, and the party or
