So much and such parts thereof as refer to the Inspection and Repairs of Public Buildings, and the Maryland Penitentiary, and the Governor's Mansion, be referred to the Committee on Public Buildings.

So much and such parts thereof as relate to the Oysters of Chesapeake Bay and its tributaries, be referred to the Special Committee already appointed on that subject.

So much and such parts thereof as relate to the Public Works and Internal Improvements of the State, to the Com-

mittee on Internal Improvements.

That so much and such parts thereof as relate to the Colored Population, be referred to the Committee on Colored Population.
