A bill entitled an Act to continue in force chapter 118 of the Laws of Maryland, passed at the January session, 1865, entitled an Act to repeal section 146 of the third Article of the Code of Public Local Laws relating to the office of Register of Wills for Baltimore county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Poteet, Chairman of a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled an Act to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Baltimore and Harford counties to levy a sum of money for the construction of a bridge over the Little Gunpowder River, at Emory's Ford,
