A bill entitled an Act to repeal section 9, of Article 19, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title Somerset county, subtitle Almshouse, and enact the following in lieu thereof.

A bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled Somerset county, so as to provide the manner and time for the appointment and the term of office of the Supervisors of Roads in said county.

Mr. Slingluff, Chairman of a select committee, reported favorably,

A bill entitled an Act to authorize and require the County Commissioners of Baltimore county to convey a lot of ground to the Board of School Commissioners of Baltimore county, to be used for a public school house site.

A bill entitled an Act to provide for the copying, binding and indexing certain chancery records in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city, and for recopying, re-binding, and re-indexing certain land records therein.
