The House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 59, of Article 16, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Prince George's county, entitled "Hucksters," and to re-enact the same with amendments, endorsed "Reported unfavorably from the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, and the report adopted."

The following House bills, severally endorsed, "Passed by yeas and nays:"

The bill entitled an Act for the relief of Columbus Scarborough, of Harford county.

The bill entitled an Act to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Washington and Allegany counties to levy a sum of money upon the taxable property within their respective counties sufficient to pay the several Clerks of the Registers of Voters within the said counties.

The bill entitled an Act in favor of the Western Maryland Rail Road Company, extending the time for the completion of its road.

The bill entitled an Act giving the assent of the State of Maryland to the purchase of a parcel of land by the Government of the United States, from Wm. H. Dorsey and others, and ceding to the United States of America the jurisdiction over the site of the North West Beacon Building or Light House, and the parcel of land thereto appurtenant in a line with the Brewerton Channel in the Patapsco River, in this State.

The bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact the Act of 1867, chapter 185, for the suppression of the crime of unlawful abortion.

The bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Baltimore Citizen Rifle Target Shooting Company.
