Mr. Bond, of Baltimore city, submitted the following amendment:

Strike out all after the word "mentis," in 10th line, section 7.

Which was rejected.

Mr. Smith, of Baltimore city, submitted the following amendment:

Strike out the 8th section.

Which was rejected.

Mr. Smith, of Baltimore city, submitted the following amendment:

In the 8th line of the 8th section, strike out the words, "such actual damage," and insert treble damages.

Which was rejected.

Mr. Mullin submitted the following amendment:

Section 10, line 2, strike out the word "or," and insert after the word "amend," the words or repeal.

Which was adopted.

The bill as amended was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Bond, of Baltimore city (the rules being suspended) submitted the following order:

Ordered, That Mr. Colton have leave of absence for this day.

Which was adopted.

On motion of Mr. Smith, of Baltimore city,

The House, at $10\frac{3}{4}$ o'clock, P. M., adjourned until tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock.
