Which was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Also,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Executive Committee of the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in the United States, with proposed amendment.

Amendment proposed:

Add to section 5, "and the General Assembly reserves the right to amend or repeal this Act, at pleasure."

The amendment was adopted, and

The bill, as amended,

Read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Also,

A bill entitled an Act to incorporate the Monumental Permanent Building and Land Society of Baltimore.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Bowlus, (the rules being suspended,) submitted the following order:

Ordered, That the special committee to whom was referred the bill in relation to the Deaf and Dumb Asylum, incorporated by Act of Assembly of 1868, be required to report by tomorrow at 11 o'clock.

Which was adopted.

Mr. Slingluff, Chairman of a select committee, reported favorably

A bill entitled an Act to establish voting precincts in the 1st, 3d, 9th, 11th and 12th Election Districts of Baltimore county.

Which was read a first time and ordered to be printed.

Mr. Clark, Chairman of a select committee, reported favorably

A bill entitled an Act to authorize the Commissioners of Howard county to subscribe to the capital stock of turnpike roads in said county.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Kean, Chairman of a select committee, reported favorably,

The Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 170, 171 and 172, of the Code of Public Local Laws, relating to Allegany county, and to re-enact the same with amendments.
