In line 29, after the word "received," insert the words "not exceeding one hundred thousand shares of one hundred dollars each."

Section 6, line 5, after the words "Rail Roads," insert the words "within Allegany county."

Section 6, line 28, after the word "constructed," insert the words within "Allegany county."
