Mr. Boyer submitted the following order:

On motion of Mr. Hubbard,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill to permit Dr. H. F. Willis to have a deed recorded in Caroline county.

On motion of Mr. Percy,

Leave was granted to the Dorchester delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to revive and continue in force the charter of the Nanticoke Bridge Company.

On motion of Mr. Keech,

Leave was granted to the Committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill to authorize and empower Joshua C. Higgins, late Deputy Sheriff of Prince George's county, under Daniel R. Dyer and John W.
