So the motion to postpone did not prevail.

Mr. Brown submitted the following amendment:

1st section, line 3, after the word "cotton" insert the words, woolen or other.

Which was adopted.

On motion of Mr. Nicolai,

The vote by which the amendment submitted by Mr. Brown was adopted,

Was reconsidered.

The question then recurring upon the adoption of the amendment,

It was again adopted.

Mr. Brown submitted the following amendment:

Section 2, line 5, after the word "cotton" insert the words, or other.

Which was adopted.

Mr. Coad submitted the following amendment:

Section 2, line 5, after the word "day" insert the words, except by agreement with the parents or guardian of such child.

Which was rejected.

Mr. Wentz submitted the following amendment:

Section 2, line 3, strike out the words "or knowingly permit."

The question being upon the adoption of the amendment,

Mr. Montague moved the previous question,

Which was sustained.

The question then being,

"Shall the previous question be now put,"

It was determined in the affirmative.

The question then recurring upon the adoption of the amendment,

It was rejected.

Mr. Iglehart submitted the following amendment:

Add at end of section 2 the following: But such person is authorized to make such contract.
