

The bill entitled an Act to repeal section 48 of Article 28, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled County Commissioners, under the head of Bridges, and to re-enact the same with amendments,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to amend the 31st section of Article 24, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Conveyancing," sub-title "Mortgages," by adding thereto and re-enacting as follows,

The bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments sections 1, 2 and 5, of Article 65, of the Code of Public General Laws, entitled "Negligence," and relating to actions for injury done to the person, or loss of life occasioned by the wrongful act, neglect or default of another,

The bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to subscribe in behalf of said county to the capital stock of the Baltimore and Drum Rail Road Company, and issue bonds for the same and provide for their redemption,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to enable John James Jackson, an alien, to hold, inherit and transmit real estate in the State of Maryland,

Was read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled an Act to amend and re-enact section 21 of Article 7 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title Carroll county, sub-title Justices of the Peace and Constables, and to repeal the Act of 1867, chapter 110, providing an additional constable for District No. 2, Carroll county,

Being upon a second reading,

Mr. Harden submitted the following amendment:

Sub-section 21, line 27, strike out the words "or immediate vicinity."
