Mr. Harden submitted the following amendment:

Section 10, line 2, strike out the word "Carroll."

Which was adopted.

On motion of Mr. Worthington,

The vote by which the amendment submitted by Mr. Harden

Was adopted,

Was reconsidered.

The question then recurring upon the adoption of the amendment,

It was rejected.

The bill, as amended, was then read a second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered
