

80. The first Congressional district shall be composed of Worcester county, Somerset county, Dorchester county, Talbot county, Caroline county, and Queen Anne's county; and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

81. The second Congressional district shall be composed of Kent county, Cecil county, Harford county, Carroll county, and the first, second, third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and thirteenth districts of Baltimore county; and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

82. The third Congressional district shall be composed of the first eight wards of Baltimore city, or all the wards on the east side of Jones' Falls, with the eighth, ninth, tenth, eleventh and twelfth districts of Baltimore county; and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

83. The fourth Congressional district shall be composed of the wards of Baltimore city, from ninth to twentieth, inclusive; or all those wards on the west side of Jones' Falls; and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

84. The fifth Congressional district shall be composed of Frederick county, Washington county, and Allegany county; and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

85. The sixth Congressional district shall be composed of Howard County, Montgomery county, Prince George's county, Charles county, Saint Mary's county, Calvert county, and Anne Arundel county, with the city of Annapolis; and shall be entitled to choose one Representative.

86. The return judges of the elections of Representatives to Congress of the first seven and thirteenth districts of Baltimore county, shall make a return separate from the return to be made by the return judges of the remaining five districts; and the return judges of the first eight wards of the city of Baltimore shall make a return separate from the return to be made by the judges of the remaining twelve wards.
