representatives, and the administrator of the person so dying shall pay the same to them.

## STATE'S ATTORNEY.

27. In all criminal cases which may be tried before a jury in the Circuit Court for Cecil county, the judge of said court may, in addition to the sum allowed by law, allow to the State's Attorney for said county such compensation, not exceeding the sum of thirty dollars for any one case, as the said judge may think just and proper, to be levied by the county commissioners.

## AUCTIONS.

- 28. No person shall vend at auction any goods, wares or merchandise of any name, kind or description whatsoever, within the limits of any incorporated town in Cecil county, or within the circuit of one mile of any such incorporated town, unless he shall first pay to the clerk of the Circuit Court for said county the sum of seventy-five dollars for such privilege for one year, or eight dollars per day for each day he may be employed in selling as aforesaid, to be applied to the use of the State and paid into the treasury thereof by said clerk.
- 29. The provisions of the aforegoing section shall apply only to such persons as shall bring goods, wares or merchandise into said county to sell at auction within the limits aforesaid, and to such persons as shall sell at auction goods, wares or merchandise sent into said county, and the limits aforesaid, for the express purpose of being sold upon commission.
- 30. Any person who shall sell as aforesaid, within the limits aforesaid, without having previously paid the license herein directed, shall be liable to a penalty of one hundred dollars for each offence, to be recovered by the State in the same manner as debts of the same amount are recoverable.
- 31. The clerk of the Circuit Court shall be entitled to the same fees and commissions for issuing the license, and paying into the treasury the money therefor, as for like licenses under the laws of this State.
