- 343. The commissioners may provide a compensation for the burgess for duties required of him as burgess and treasurer.
- 344. The burgess shall report annually to the commissioners, during the first two days of their session, the general state of the town, with an accurate account of the money received and expended, to be published for the information of the citizens.
- 345. All fines and forfeitures, under the ordinances of the said corporation, shall be recoverable before the burgess or a justice of the peace, as small debts are; and the burgess shall be entitled to the same fees as a justice of the peace for similar services.
- 346. All fines and forfeitures shall be recovered in the name and for the use of the burgess and commissioners of Woodsboro', and no fine or forfeiture shall exceed the sum of twenty dollars for any one offence.
