### ALMS-HOUSE.

SECTION 1. The county commissioners of Washington county shall, at their first meeting in the month of May in each year, appoint three discreet persons, inhabitants of said county, to be Trustees of the Poor in said county, from and after the first Monday of June then next ensuing.
