The Board consists of the Governor, Comptroller, Treasurer, exofficio members, and six others appointed by the Governor, with the consent of the Senate; two bi-ennially for a term of six years from the first day in May. (Bagby Code, Art. 44, Sec. 16.)

Patients are received upon order of the Supervisors of City Charities of Baltimore City, and the various County Commissioners, who pay the hospital \$125.00 per capita per annum, the certificates of two physicians being required in all cases.

The institution grounds now cover 1,255 acres. There are nearly 2,030 patients in the hospital and 100 on parole. Two additional cottages have been added, one to the men's group and one to the women's group.
