

CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

(Amending Sections 2 and 3 of Article VI) Proposed by Chapter 133 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1929; confers upon the Legislature power to authorize deputies employed in the Treasury Department, to sign, countersign and grant warrants, and to sign, countersign and issue checks for the withdrawal of funds from the Treasury of the State under regulations prescribed by the Legislature.
