Chapter 358 of the Acts of 1937 as amended by Chapter 741 of the Acts of 1939 specifies the duties of the Administrator and directs that no person, co-partnership or corporation shall engage in the business of making loans of money, credits, goods, or things in action, in the amount or to the value, of \$300.00 or less, and charge, contract for or receive a greater rate of interest than six per centum per annum therefor without first having obtained a license from the Administrator of Loan Laws. The cost of maintaining the office is borne by the licensees operating under the Small Loan Law.
