the provisions and limitations of said Act. The Commission is charged with the duty of assisting Maryland ex-service men and women and Veterans or their dependents, who are residents of Maryland, who are or may be entitled to aid from the United States Government pursuant to Federal Legislation for the benefit of Veterans and their dependents, in preparing and presenting their claims to the proper Federal authorities and agencies, and in securing and expediting action thereon; and the Commission is further charged with the duty of making and preserving a permanent registry of the graves of all persons who served in the Military or Naval forces of the United States in time of war and who are buried in the State of Maryland.
