The functions of the Commission shall be to promote traffic safety on the streets and highways and in other public places throughout the State of Maryland; to co-ordinate the activities of public and private agencies interested in or affected by the problems of traffic safety; and to assist such agencies and to augment their activites by study, education and information.

To carry out its functions, the Commission may require any State, County, municipal or other public agency of this State to supply information and assistance for the Commission in the performance of its duties; may co-operate with private business, educational and charitable organizations and private individuals interested in traffic safety; and may appoint sub-committees in the counties and municipalities of the State to assist in its work.
