LEGAL HOLIDAYS

1. Fixed

January 1.....	New Year's Day
February 12.....	Lincoln's Birthday
February 22.....	Washington's Birthday
March 25.....	Maryland Day
May 30.....	Decoration Day
July 4.....	Independence Day
September 12.....	Defenders' Day
October 12.....	Columbus Day
November 11.....	Armistice Day
December 25.....	Christmas Day

Should any of the dates listed above fall on a Sunday, the holiday is observed on the following Monday.

2. Movable

The Friday before Easter Day.....	Good Friday
The first Monday in September.....	Labor Day
The fourth Thursday in November.....	Thanksgiving Day

All days of General and Congressional Elections.

All special days that may be appointed or recommended by the Governor of Maryland or the President of the United States.

3. Saturdays

It is lawful for banks in Maryland to close their doors at twelve o'clock noon on every Saturday of the year. After twelve o'clock noon, Saturday is a legal holiday. This does not apply in the following counties: Baltimore, Caroline, Howard, and Talbot. (1947 Supplement to the Annotated Code of Public General Laws, Art. 13, Sec. 11).

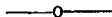
Special Observances

Resolutions of the General Assembly have authorized the Governor to proclaim special "Days" as follows:

Republic of Lithuania Day (Res. No. 8, 1935).....	February 16
Arbor Day (Res. No. 7, 1894).....	One day in April
General Pulaski Memorial Day (Res. No. 5, 1931).....	October 11
Republic of Czechoslovakia Day (Res. No. 3, 1935).....	October 28

NAMES AND ORIGINS OF COUNTIES

ALLEGANY
