Saturdays

It shall be lawful for any banking institution to remain closed on any one or more or all Saturdays, a

or more or an Saturdays, and the such bank may remain closed shall constitute a legal holiday. This provision shall not apply in the sounties of Queen Anne's and Saturday, (Code 1957 supp., Art. 13, sec. 10).

It is lawful for banks in Maryland to close their doors at twelve o'clock noon on every Saturday of the year. After twelve o'clock noon, Saturday is a legal holiday. This does not apply in Howard and Talbot counties (Code 1955 supp., Art. 13, sec. 12).
