## CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

## Chapter 100-Acts of 1956

An Act to propose an amendment to Section 1A of Article I of the Constitution of Maryland, title "Elective Franchise", providing for absentee voting at elections in this State by CERTAIN persons unable to vote personally by reason of physical disability.

## Chapter 124-Acts of 1956

An Act to propose an amendment to Section 40 of Article 4 of the Constitution of Maryland, title "Judiciary Department", sub-title "Part V—Orphans' Courts", providing that Judges of the several Orphans' Courts shall be paid such compensation as may be regulated by law.
