The Governor appointed this special committee in 1962 to make a thorough investigation of the problems of unemployment among out-of-school unemployed youth, age 16 to 21, among workers displaced because of automation or mechanization, and among older workers, age 40 to 65. The committee consists of ten members of whom seven already have been appointed. The Governor will name three additional members and designate a Chairman at a later date. To assist the committee, the Governor also appointed a ten-member technical advisory committee composed of representatives of State agencies. The Committee will report its findings to the Governor and to the Legislative Council.
