

purchased by State agencies, which receive invoices and make payment to the Revolving Fund in the same manner as to other vendors (Code 1957, Art. 15A, secs. 28-34).

Since March 6, 1949, the Department has distributed donable foods from the Consumer and Marketing Service, U. S. Department of Agriculture, to public and private eleemosynary institutions and agencies and to needy families in the State of Maryland. There are 173 such institutions and agencies serving approximately 106,000 persons.

In March 1960, a Central Services program was inaugurated providing typewriter repair and duplicating services for those agencies located in the Baltimore State Office Building and for certain agencies in the Baltimore area.
