

STATE-WIDE REFERENDUM

Chapter 29, Acts of the Special Session of March 11, 1964  
(Senate Bill 15)

An Act to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 11 of Article 49B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1963 Supplement), title "Interracial Commission", sub-title "Discrimination in Public Accommodations"; and to add new Section 11A to the said Article and sub-title of the Code to follow immediately after Section 11 thereof; to repeal Section 16 of said Article, sub-title "Enforcement Powers of Commission"; amending the laws concerning discrimination in certain forms of public accommodations in this State and also the laws concerning the enforcement powers of the Interracial Commission, clarifying the application of the law concerning public accommodations and prohibiting the receiving of remuneration by persons for participating in racial demonstrations and providing penalties for violations; and to repeal Section 2 of Chapter 228 of the Acts of 1963, repealing present provisions for a referendum election of the effect of these sub-titles in Carroll County.
